What Are The Hardware Considerations When Using Accoya?

All wood types contain organic acids varying in amount between species, Accoya has a similar level to oak and western cedar, which in moist conditions, may accelerate water induced corrosion in metals.

As a key component of the door or window itself, it's important to select and correctly install suitable hardware, ensuring long lasting functionality and exceptional aesthetics that your beautiful Accoya doors and windows deserve.

Sharing similar values of longevity and durability, and a desire to enhance the performance of timber doors and windows, Coastal Group have developed a suited range of hardware suitable for use with Accoya. This includes:

- External Door Furniture
- Window Furniture
- Hinges
- Fixings
- Multipoint Door Locks
- Sliding door system
- Window system and espag bolts

External Door Furniture

Tests have proven that the best performing metal in damp or exposed conditions when using Accoya, is high quality stainless steel.

It is important to take precautions if using lesser grade metals. The metal and/or the Accoya wood should be coated or otherwise separated to avoid direct contact between the wood and these metals.

However, it's worth bearing in mind if the paint or hardware coating gets chipped or damaged, the metal underneath will be exposed and is likely to corrode if it's not stainless steel.

Coastal Group has developed a wide range of suited hardware made from high quality stainless steel - it's BLU and DURATIQUE ranges - which are ideal for use with Accoya.







Window Furniture

Window furniture components such as stays, handles and finger pulls are, in the main, more classified as 'lower risk' with less exposure to moisture than door furniture.

However consideration should be given to areas with high corrosion levels as when windows are open, the furniture is exposed to the elements.

Coastal's BLU range of window furniture is made from high quality A4/316 marine grade stainless steel. It is ideal for use with Accoya as well as in coastal environments.

Hinges

As a key component of the door or window's functionality, it's important that hinges are designed with the durability to last.


Butt hinges for external doors, windows and gates should be stainless steel, with A4/316 stainless steel offering the ultimate durability and protection from corrosion.

- HQ45 (4x4) Projection Hinge is durability tested to 100,000 cycles on 160kg door over 3 hinges. Ideal for door applications such as orangeries where the door needs to clear brickwork or cills.



Coastal offers a selection of butt hinges for windows from its BLU range. They're made from A4/316 marine grade stainless steel and include:

- HY3 Slim Knuckle Window Hinge - tested to 40kg window over 2 hinges - 25,000 cycles
- FH70 Tritus Flush Lift-Off Butt Hinge - meets the requirements of BS DS EN 1935: 2002 Grade 9: 25,000 cycles / 60kg window
- HX Stormproof - tested to 108,000 cycles to 40kg over 2 hinges or 50kg over 3 hinges per sash

These hinges come with a lifetime guarantee and are available in a range of finishes.



View the range of BLU 316 stainless steel door and window hinges




Fixings

Best practice for fixings:

- Any screws or bolts exposed to moisture including screws for hinges, locks, door handles and other door furniture as well as screws for window and door installations should be stainless steel.
- Glazing pins used on both sides of external doors and windows should be stainless steel.

Coastal's stainless steel screws are made from A2/304 stainless steel, providing suitable protection from corrosion and when used in conjunction with Accoya.

Tilt and Turn Window Hardware

A very versatile system suitable for tilt & turn window and juliet balcony applications made from Accoya.



Casement Window Hardware

For casement windows requiring espag bolt locking then either the MACO Tricoat-Evo MKV Shootbolt system or the RAIL espag bolt are both ideal for use with Accoya.



NOTE: The precautions detailed on page 15 should still be followed to create a barrier between the metal and the wood.

Precautions

Even when using stainless steel / corrosion resistant locks, or locks with a TRICOAT finish (or equivalent), the following precautions should be taken and all are based on creating a barrier between metal and the wood.



- Cut-outs, such as lock housings and letter plate cut-outs should be fully end grain sealed including spindle and cylinder lock cut-outs. Ideally, the whole length of the euro-groove for espagnolette and shootbolts should be fully end grain sealed ready for an application of paint.
- The machined edges of doors and sashes should be fully painted with as much paint behind the lock as on the face.
- Further protection can be achieved by spraying the lock and mechanism with either PTFE or lithium grease. Proprietary protection kits may be used such as the CoastGard™ Corrosion Protection System.

Additionally, handle fixings and spindles ideally should be stainless steel, if not available, apply a coating of PTFE, lithium grease or similar to offer a degree of water repellency.

CoastGard™ Corrosion Protection System.

This three-part kit helps provide additional protection for hardware such as multipoint door locks and window espagnolette bolts from corroding when fitted in Accoya or coastal locations.

- CoastGard 1 (CPS-1) is a fully synthetic grease which penetrates all the moving hardware parts. It protects and lubricates the moving parts and ensures that the lacquer applied in step 3 does not stick the sliding surfaces together.
- CoastGard 2 (CPS-2) is a non-flammable cleaner spray that flushes dirt, surface rust, grease and oil from the hardware.
- CoastGard 3 (CPS-3) is a fast-drying acrylic lacquer used to protect the hardware against mild acids, alkalis, salt spray and general weathering. It seals and protects the hardware leaving a smooth, transparent, scratch resistant film which is extremely tough and durable.
