

ACCOYA COLOR HEARTWOOD BOARDS

An economical alternative to A1

Product Guide

Accoya Color is produced by impregnating Accoya with a non-toxic water-based pigment system. The colour system is fade-resistant and does not leach from the uncoated boards. Boards containing heartwood do not uniformly colour and are categorised ACO HA1 (H for Heartwood).

These boards are a more economical alternative to standard A1 boards.

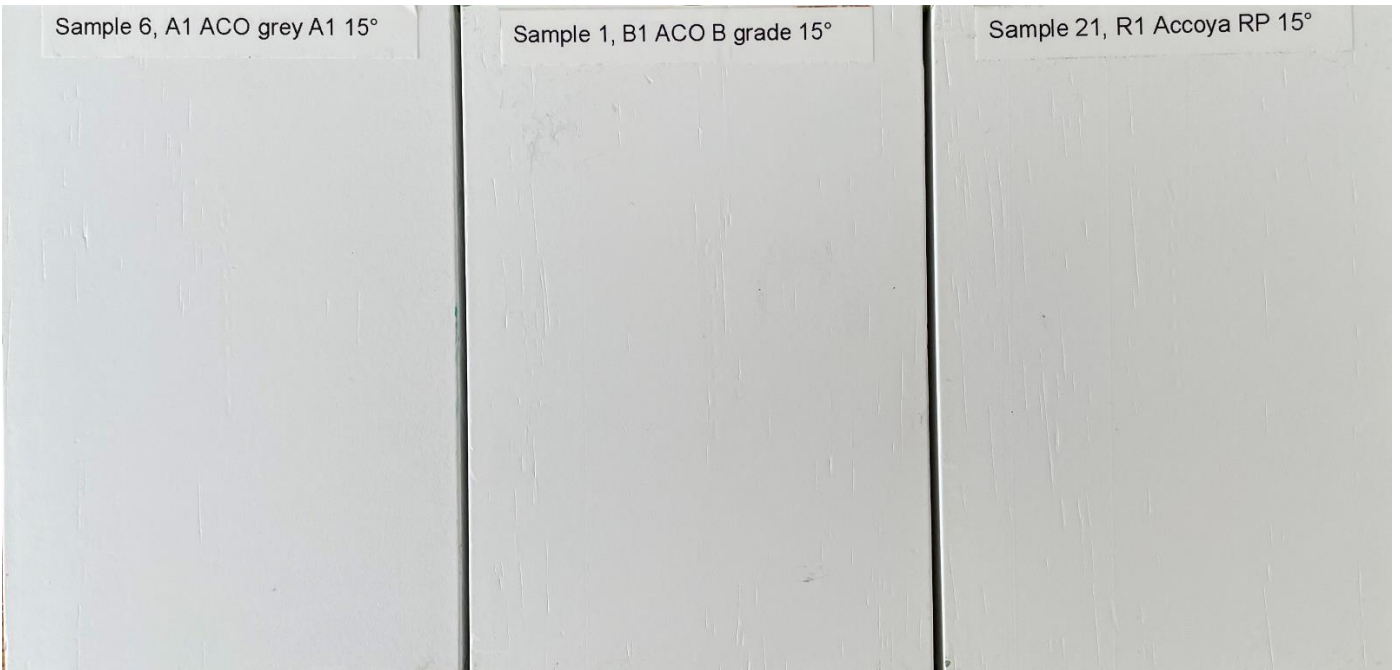

Teknos took the initiative on demonstrating suitability of their joinery coating systems for application to Accoya Color components.



This work included:
Review of coated samples on the Accsys Arnhem test field for two years.
Extreme climate chamber exposure at the Teknos Danish laboratories.

Results:
Teknos is confident that provided their standard Accoya coatings recommendations are followed there will be no discolouration of their coatings from the pigment in Accoya Color grey.
Other coatings system may work but have not been tested to date.
